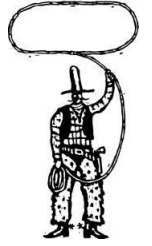
## BULLETIN

- ✓ The church also had a special collection for the Week of Compassion tornado relief fund. This collection raised \$2010.00. Donations to the Compassion Response Fund and Designated Tornado Funding will be used not only in the immediate response, but also to support long-term recovery efforts in Joplin Missouri.
- ✓ During June, our outreach theme is learning more about Tennyson Center for Children at Colorado Christian Home. This past Sunday, Bob Cooper, the Executive Director spoke during our worship time. The Colorado Christian Home started as an orphanage in 1904. Today Tennyson Center is one of the Rocky Mountain region's leading centers for abused, neglected and at-risk youths. 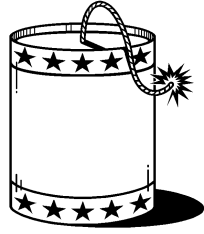
