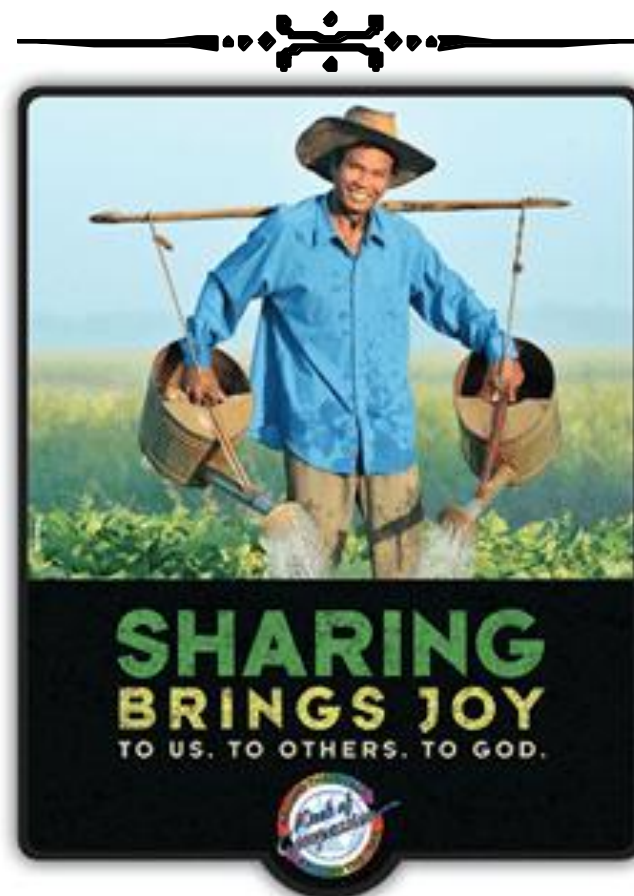

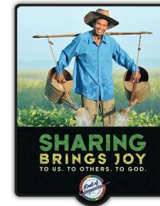

## Week of Compassion

Look inside your bulletin. You have a Week of Compassion (WOC) box with a piece of paper inserted in it, as well as a flyer about Week of Compassion.

The paper inside your box has one of four challenging situations in the world today. The four categories highlighted are **Children, Disaster Relief, Basic Education, and Hunger**. Each category has a daily situation to talk and think about as well as a unit amount. **You** decide the size of your monetary unit. Finally, you are asked to bring your box **back next week** and place it with everyone else's in front of the Communion table.

While studying and discussing your WOC daily situations, take time to remember the sharing calendar theme for 2012 **Sharing brings joy**. The purpose of this calendar is to help us remember and give thanks for our abundant blessings, as well as highlight some of the challenging situations in our world. Consider your household's contribution for the day, and add it to your box. Then offer a prayer for the people and situations highlighted in your sharing calendar and for the people your household will meet in the coming hours:

Thank you, God, for the presence, guidance, comfort and joy you bring to our lives each day--often through interactions with others. Today as we offer our gifts, we pray especially for (the day's highlighted group, if applicable). Help us to see both the blessings and needs around us, and to show your love through our actions. In Jesus' name we pray. Amen.




## CREATIVITY LAB
