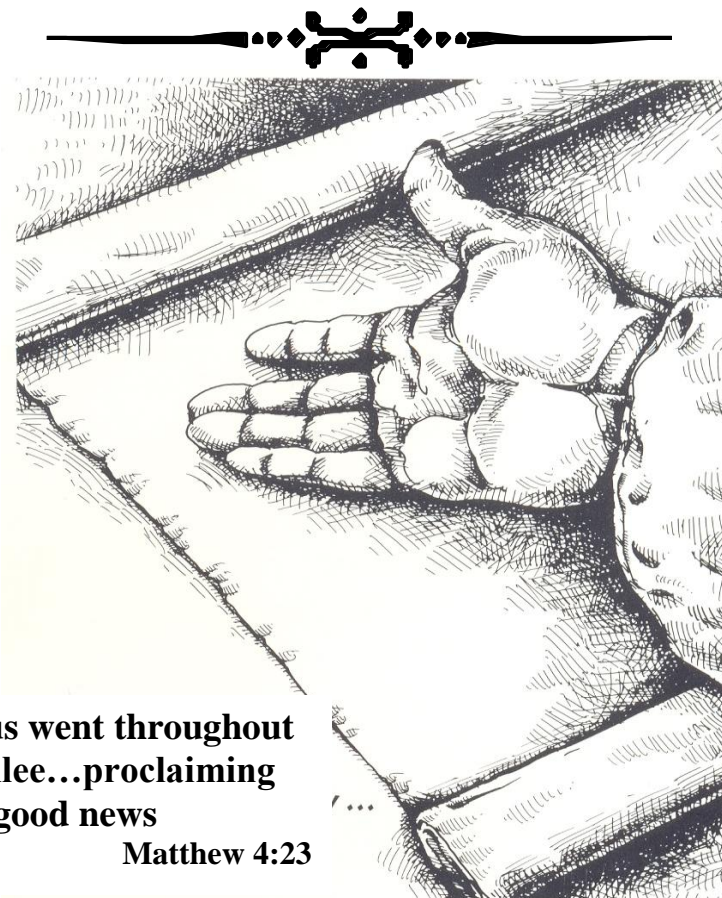

COMMUNITY MINISTRY ADDITIONAL FOOD BANK HOURS

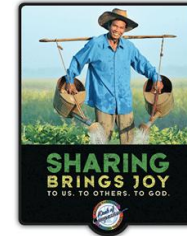
