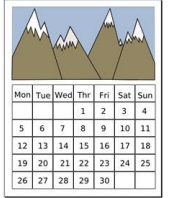

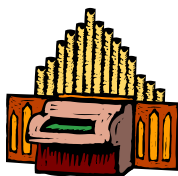


### SOUND OF THE ROCKIES:
